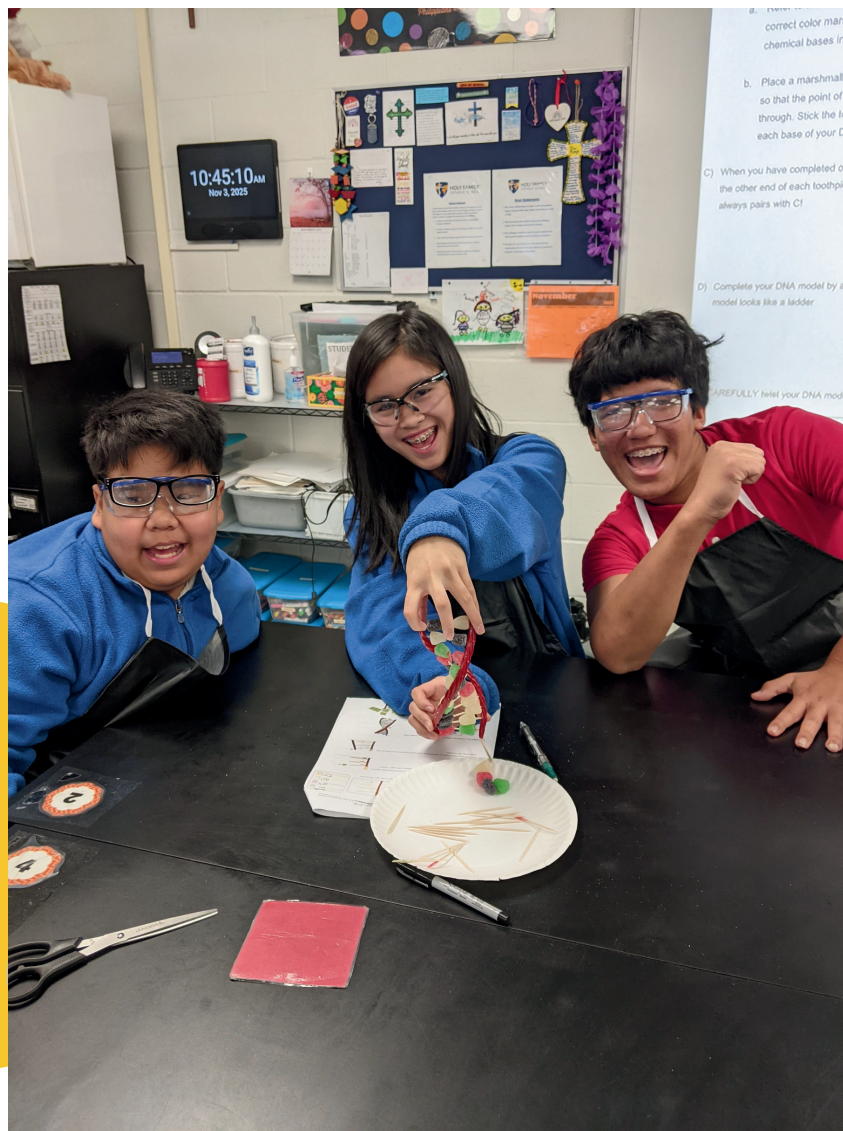

SCHOOL UPDATES FROM OUR PRINCIPAL

Thanks to the generous support of the Holy Family School Inner City Youth Foundation and grants from the Hibernians, we were able to make several important improvements to our school this year, including:

- Installation of the Quicklert security system, which provides enhanced campus safety through intrusion detection, classroom and hallway notifications, security cameras, and a messaging system for both school hours and after-hours protection.
- Upgraded entrance door security system.
- Fresh painting throughout the school.
- Improved landscaping around the school grounds.
- Professional development opportunities for our teaching staff.

We would also like to extend our sincere thanks to the Chrysalis Foundation for its continued support of our after-school Creative Learning Program for our middle school girls.

In addition, we are grateful to Prairie Meadows for awarding us a grant to help launch a youth soccer program for our students. We are excited to introduce this new opportunity during the 2026–2027 school year.

EDUCATIONAL NUMBERS

Overall Math Knowledge – Holy Family Catholic School has achieved another record-high level of math proficiency! Even more exciting, the percentage of students who are not yet proficient has been cut in half since 2021.

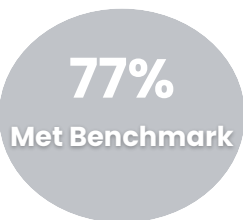
Basic Math Speed – Through a combination of schoolwide policies that emphasize manual computation and targeted interventions, student math speed proficiency remains exceptionally strong at 93%.

Overall Reading Comprehension – Reading comprehension continues to improve reaching a new record high of 73% proficiency.

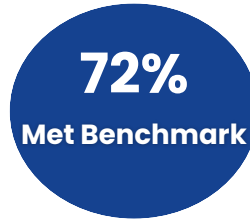
Quick Reading Comprehension – Reading proficiency remains strong, with 88% of students demonstrating quick proficiency.

Reading Accurately with Speed – After our first full year of assessing all students, reading fluency has shown a remarkable turnaround, reaching a new record high of 72% proficiency.

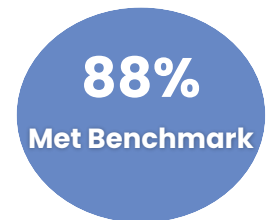
Math Knowledge



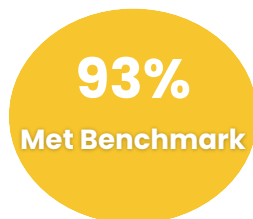
Reading with Speed



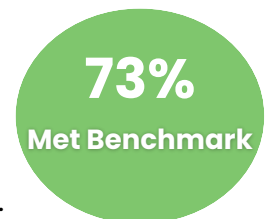
Quick Comprehension

Reading Comprehension



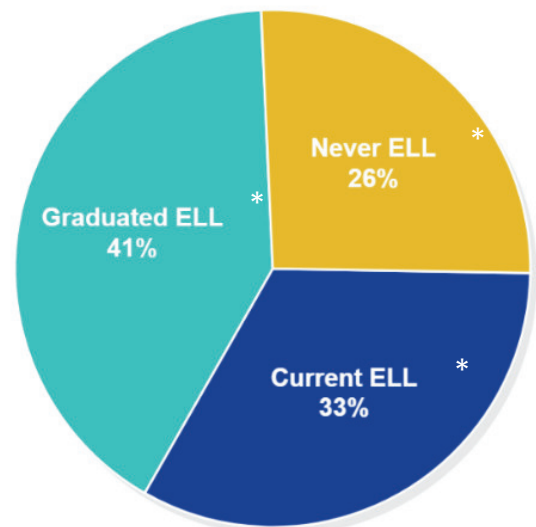
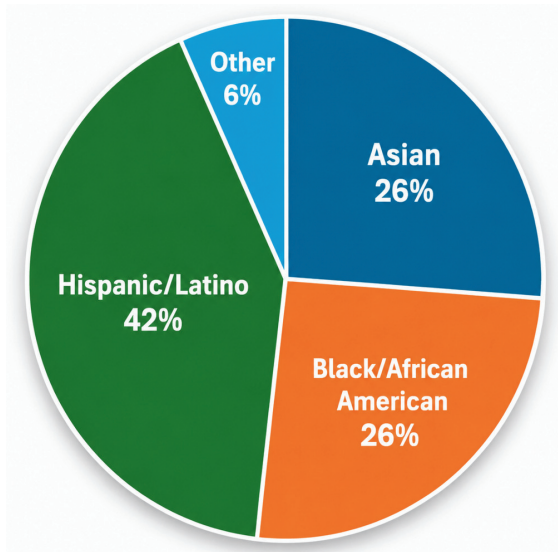
Met Benchmark: Performance met or exceeded the established state benchmark, indicating students are on track for grade-level expectations.

Qualified Charitable Distributions—If you are age 70½ or older, a qualified charitable distribution (QCD) offers a tax smart way to support the HFSICY Foundation. You may transfer up to \$111,000 annually (as adjusted by the IRS) directly from your IRA to the Foundation. Your gift can satisfy all or part of your required minimum distribution (RMD), if applicable, and the transferred amount is generally excluded from your taxable income.
