

Computers for every student allowed us to to transition to online learning when COVID-19 forced closure in March. We continued our school year completely online.


Partnerships with the Des Moines Public Schools and the Des Moines Area Religious Council Food Pantry provided nutritional needs for students and families during the time they were away from school.


Stewardship
