Dear Holy Family Catholic School Friends,

By any measure, the 2020-2021 school year, while challenging, was a resounding success. We entered the year with many unknowns, but absolutely committed to have all our students in school, every day, with zero interruptions. This required our teachers to develop skills on the delivery of instruction in a manner they never thought possible. It also required from the families we serve to work with us to minimize the risk of illness by being proactive in keeping children home if they became ill. Through creativity, hard work, and many prayers, we were able to meet our goal of having our students in school without interruption.



Every year we assess our students on their academic skills to inform teachers on what areas the students need additional support, whether remediation or enrichment. In the past we utilized the Iowa Assessments for this measurement. Last year, we used a different assessment called the Iowa Statewide Assessment of Student Progress (ISASP). On the following page you will see how our students performed on this assessment. Considering the impact of COVID-19 on learning loss and being the first time students took the assessment, we are pleased with our students progress, and we are confident these scores will improve as teachers utilize the data to guide instruction.

Most of our students come to us speaking a language other than English as their primary language. During the 2020-21 school year, 86 of our 225 students qualified for English Language instruction, and we assess their progress annually to determine whether they require further support as they gain language proficiency. Due to their exceptional performance on this assessment, 26 students exited our EL program. We put a lot of time and resources into ensuring our students have the language skills necessary to be successful in and out of the classroom and we are proud of their hard work.

Our students demonstrate consistent growth because our teachers are committed to seeing their students reach their highest potential. Our parents have high expectations for their children, and this results in increased student performance. Finally, our students are successful because of the broad community support Holy Family receives from those who give their time, talent, and treasure to sustain our efforts. This synchronicity of effort results in a school that provides a 21st century, faith-filled education for our community of learners.



LOOKING BACK AT HOW IT STARTED

As we celebrate the Foundation's 30th Anniversary we recognize three Sisters who helped start it all! These three Sisters were instrumental in the early years of consolidating Des Moines' inner-city Catholic schools.



Sister Shirley Marie Crisler — Sister of Charity

Sister Shirley Marie Crisler was born in 1926, graduated from Madonna in 1944 and then worked as a secretary until she entered the Springfield Dominicans in September 1946. She served as co-principal at Sacred Heart in Des Moines and as principal at Visitation in Des Moines where she was instrumental in the consolidation that started Holy Family. After retiring as principal, she continued to teach GED classes until her full retirement at age 80. Sister Shirley Marie Crisler passed away on August 10, 2018.



Sister Mary Andrew Osborne — Sister of Mercy

Sister Mary Andrew Osborne was born in 1937. She was received into religious life as a Sister of Mercy on August 16, 1956. Most of her professional life was spent in Des Moines where she was a first grade teacher at Saint Peter's School for 15 years. When Saint Peter's merged with Visitation, Saint Ambrose, and Saint John's to become Holy Family she became co-principal of the three buildings. Sister Mary Andrew Osborne passed away on January 26, 1999.



Sister Joanne Simonini — BVM

Sister Joanne Simonini was born in 1931, in Des Moines, Iowa. She attended St. Ambrose Elementary School and St. Joseph Academy in Des Moines. She entered the Sisters of Charity of the Blessed Virgin Mary congregation in 1951, from Holy Trinity Parish, Des Moines. She professed her final vows on July 16, 1959.

Sister Joanne ministered in Des Moines as principal and primary teacher at St. John, principal at Holy Family, and director of religious education at St. Joseph. Sister Joanne Simonini passed away on April 24, 2021.
